Upon reading the recommendation and order of Honorable H. C. DePae, dated November 19, 1929, recommending confirmation of the sale of the land of the bankrupt to W. B. Hyde, latter and Missus Rankin latter, it is

Ordered that the sale be and the same is hereby confirmed and that the trustee, Henry C. Lawrence, do make and deliver unto the said W. B. Hyde, latter and Missus Rankin latter for the consideration of One Thousand and no/100 Dollars, a deed to said land. The following is a description of the land to be conveyed:

All that certain tract of land in Greeneville County, South Carolina, - containing Ninety-three and 27/100 (93.27) Acres, more or less, as shown by a plat compiled and made by W. D. News, September 24, 1921, and filed with the trustee. Said land lies about five miles north of Greenville Court House, S. C. and on the north side of Suncamp Road, - being all the land listed in the schedule of the Bankrupt above named. Said land was conveyed to Lloyd Hughes by deed from W. A. Hodges, dated July 29, 1918, recorded in the S. M. S. Office for Greenville County in Volume 51, page 162, and from Parker Land Company, dated May 5, 1928, recorded in Volume 25, page 510.

A plat of the said lands is recorded in Plat Book C, page 276, in the S. M. S. Office for said Greenville County, South Carolina.
