It is ordered: That the prayer of the said petition be, and it is hereby granted, and the said Trustee, H. D. Lawner, is directed to sell free and clear of all encumbrances at public auction at or in front of Greensville Court House, Greensville County, S. C., on said said Court House, at 12:00 M. on November 4, 1929, (which is the first Monday in November, 1929) the said property hereinafter described, and that the Trustee shall give notice of said sale by advertising in a newspaper of general circulation in said County (Greensville News) and that said notice shall be published thirty days before said sale, and shall continue to be published once a week thereafter prior to November 4, 1929, and that said sale shall be subject to the approval of the Court; that the referee will hold a meeting of creditors at 5:00 o'clock, P.M., November 4, 1929, for the purpose of receiving the receiver's report of sale.
