KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. D. O. Patterson,  
of the County of Greenville

In the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of  
one thousand five hundred and  
fifty dollars, paid me in hand paid  
at and before the sealing of these presents by and for other good and valuable considerations.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said John O'Rourke all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the state of South Carolina, County of Greenville, a short distance north of the city limits of Greenville, being known and designated as lot 401 (one) at a plat made by Dalton A. Nease, dated October, 1925 (7 Book 96, lot # 1240-1), and having according to said plat the following initial and boundary, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pipe on the North side of South Woodside Circle at the line between lots 69 and 70, as shown on C. M. Turners Plat dated March 5, 1929, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds Conveyances for said County and State in Plat Book "C", at page 219; and running thence along South Woodside Circle S. 87° E. fifty eight and eight-tenths (58.8) feet to an iron pipe on corner of lot 62; thence N. 2° 54' E. one hundred thirty one and four-tenths (131.4) feet along line of lot 2 to an iron pipe on front corner of lots 1, 2, 3 and 6; thence N. 74° W. fifty four and one tenth (54.1) feet along line of lot 6 to a pipe on the line between lots 60 and 61 on the Johnson plat above referred to; thence S. 28° 54' W. one hundred and forty five (145) feet along lines of lots 61, 62 and 70 (on the Turners Plat) to the beginning corner

The above described land is part of the same conveyed to me by J. W. Leeward, Jr.  
on the 29 day of September 1924, deed recorded in office of Register  
of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 73, Page 255  
TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.  
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said grantee and his

heirs and assigns, forever.  
Subject to the terms of the Agreement entered into between said grantor and H. T. Pace, Jr., on the eleventh day of April, 1925, whereby the said H. T. Pace, Jr., was granted the right to lay and set accordingly, lay an eight inch sewer pipe across or near said lot of land, together with the right to repair and replace said pipe at any time; provided, that any damage to said land caused by said pipe or to any buildings, shrubbery or other improvements thereon caused by repairing or replacing said pipe should be paid by the person repairing or replacing the same to any one damaged thereby; provided further that the owner of any land then belonging to said grantor should have the right at any time to connect with said sewer pipe, if so desired, do hereby bind

myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said grantee and his

heirs and assigns, against me my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
