(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Mrs Alice Paris Kelly, All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in High Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and Having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone on road, said road running thence S 44° 20' N 1570.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 25-15 E. 510 feet to a stone; thence N. 58-45 E. 258 feet to White Oak (dead and down) now stone in place; thence S. 32-15 E. 290 feet to a stone; thence N. 52-15 E. 1069 feet to a stone; thence N. 17-30 W. 1211 feet to the beginning corner, containing 2.9 acres more or less, bounded by lands of Mrs. Lizzie bald well, Bee Cannon, Grady Smith, and J. E. Hall, and Being the same tract of land conveyed to me by L. F. Reese by deed dated June 19th. 1924, and recorded in Public Office for Greenville County in Book 83, Page 339. Also all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in the State and County aforesaid in Highland Township and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin corner of J.
