Good, and estate of R. Maye leleveland & J. Norwood
leleveland. This property lies on both sides of the
Greer Highway, South of our Store Building, and East
of leleveland Avenue north of our store Building.
It is agreed the right and power line is to run
across the street as practical.

and to construct and maintain in, upon, and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for
the purpose of transmitting power by electricity, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines and
making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines all trees and other obstructions that may, in
any way, endanger the proper operation of the same.
