KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, William E. Langford

of said County and State, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) and privilege for connecting lights and power, if desired, Dollar to M.L. in hand paid by the SOUTHERN PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPANY, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant unto the said SOUTHERN PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPANY, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege, and easement to go in and upon the certain tract or tracts of land situated in said County and State, bounded by lands of

- A. P. Southerlinon the north and west,
- O. J. L. Pritchett on the south, and the Geer Highway on the east

and to construct and maintain in, upon, and through said premises, in a proper manner, with poles, wires and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for the purpose of transmitting power by electricity, together with the right at all times to enter upon said premises for the purpose of inspecting said lines and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon; together with the right to cut away and keep clear of said lines all trees and other obstructions that may, in any way, endanger the proper operation of the same.

It being expressly agreed that the poles are to be placed as near the Geer Highway as the State laws permit.
