All that Certain Piece, Parcel or Lot of Land situated lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County and township of Greenville, about two miles North West from Greenville Court House near the American Spinning Co. and being known and designated as lots #16 and 17 said lots adjoining each other and together having the following metes and bounds to-wit:
Beginning at a point on Mc Crary line running Church St. N. 59 1/2 E. 133 ft. to Church St. thence with Church St., N. 21 2/4 W. 140 ft. to corner street, thence with the line of Hudson Street 59 1/4 W. 133 ft. to a point on Hudson Street 2120 E. 140 ft. to the beginning being the same two lots of land conveyed to J.
