All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, according to plat made of said property by Dalton & Neves, Engrs. October, 1929, and being known as Lot No. 6 of Plat No. 1 of the property of J. F. Freeman, and recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Plat Book "G", page 250, and being described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the National Highway at a corner on Lee Road as shown on said plat, running thence with Lee Road S. 3.50 W. 74 feet to corner of Lot No. 7; thence along the line of Lot No. 7 N. 76.33 E. 107.8 to line of Lot No. 5; thence along line of Lot No. 5 N. 13.11 W. 70.9 feet to the National Highway; thence along the National Highway S. 76.33 W. 86 feet to the point of beginning.
