lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, about two miles
west of the City of Greenville, near Morgan Mill,
and having the following metes and bounds
according to the plat of Morgan Hill Addition,
same recorded in the R.M.C. Office for
Greenville County in Plat Book A, pages 68 and
69, Beginning at an iron pin on Morgan
Street, front corner of Lot no. 31 and 32,
and running N 4° 44' W 200 feet to an iron
pin; thence S 82° 31' W 60 feet to an iron pin;
thence S 7° 4' E. 200 feet to an iron pin on
Morgan Street, thence along Morgan Street N.
82° 31' E. 60 feet to the beginning corner, being
Lot no 31 on the above mentioned plat.

This deed is made pursuant to powers
conferred upon me in the deed by J. A. Hughey
to me, dated May 19th, 1928, recorded in Book
136, page 262.

This conveyance is made in full satis-
faction and discharge of the mortgage by
R. H. Partridge to Julia D. Charles, Attorney, in the
amount of \$1,500.00, dated May 18th, 1928, recorded
in R. M.C. O. for Greenville County in Book 91, page
116.

This conveyance is made, subject to any
taxes that may exist against said property.
It is further agreed that this mortgage
may be held open by the grantee to protect
the title against any intervening encumbrance.
