L. Simpson, other lands of R. A. Fowler, and others, and more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pipe in the line of R. L. Simpson, said iron pipe being N. 81 W. 57.5 feet from where the said line intersects the center line of the Piedmont and Northern Railway track, and running thence from said iron pipe with the line of the right-of-way of the said Piedmont and Northern Railway N. 3 - 46 E. 100 feet to an iron pipe; thence N. 81 W. 100 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 3 - 46 W. 100 feet to an iron pipe in the line of said R.
