All those parcels or tracts of land situate in the State and County aforesaid about 4 miles north of the Greenville County Court House and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of Paris Mountain Road, joint corners, of Musser and Starkey and running thence N. 3-45 E. 616 feet with Harris and Greene's property to a stone; thence S. 89-15 E. 118 feet to a stone; thence S. 3-45 W. 380 feet, more or less, to a pin on center of Paris Mountain Road; thence down the center of Paris Mountain Road S. 53-20 W. 70 feet, more or less, to a pin in the center of said Road, thence continuing with said Road S. 28-35 W. 200 feet to the beginning, containing 1.36 acres, more or less, and being the same tract conveyed to me by Flora H. Sherman by deed dated October 26, 1925, recorded in Deed Book 98, page 240, R. M. C. office for said County.

Also: All that tract of land situate on road leading from Paris Mountain Road to the Finlay place about 100 yards from Paris Mountain Road adjoining lands of Hubbard, Rob't Reaves and Whitmire, containing 2 acres, more or less.

Also: All that tract of land adjoining lands now or formerly of David Whitmire and Roberts and on Road leading from Mountain Creek Church road to the Finlay place and known as the Elias Roberts home place containing (14) Fourteen acres, more or less.

Also; All that tract of land situate on the North side of paris Mountain Road adjoining lands of Smith Hubbard, Boling and Reaves, containing Three and Forty five hundreths (3.45) acres, and having such metes and bounds as shown in deed from Jerry Boling to G. W. Greene, recorded in Vol. 23, page 64.
