Whereas, J. F. Adams, et al.,

on or about the 8th day of November in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty eight exhibited their  
complaint in the  
Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against J. A. Adams,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 28th  
day of November 1928, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was

adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman  
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Vanoy Johnson, Harold Johnson, Sadie Johnson, Smith, Frances  
Johnson Miller, Helen Johnson and (Lois Johnson),  
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. D 244)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman  
Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree.

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Vanoy Johnson,  
Harold Johnson, Sadie Johnson Smith, Frances Johnson Miller, Helen Johnson, and Lois  
Johnson, the following described real estate, reserving, however, an estate for life  
to J. A. Adams; ✓

"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in  
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Laurens Road, about  $3\frac{1}{2}$  miles East  
of the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning  
at an iron pin on the Laurens Road 105 feet N. 32 W. from corner of Conyers & Gower's  
land facing said road, and runs thence with said road N. 32 W. 215 feet, more or less,  
to another lot deeded to Curtis Hamby, et al.; thence with this lot S.  $36\frac{1}{4}$  W. 3.17 chs.  
to an iron pin; thence S. 32 E. 100 feet, more or less, to line of land conveyed to  
J. F. Adams; thence with his line S.  $36\frac{1}{4}$  W. 7.68 chs. more or less, to an iron pin;  
thence S. 51 E. 105 feet to an iron pin at corner of land conveyed to Curtis Hamby,  
et al.; thence with said line N.  $36\frac{1}{4}$  E. 10.85 chs. to the beginning corner."
