I, E. Inman
Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:
Whereas, Vanoy Johnson, et al.

on or about the 9th day of November in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty three exhibited their complaint in the
Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Lois Johnson, et al.

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 8th
day of December 1933, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was
adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman,
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Vanoy Johnson, Harold Johnson, Sadie J. Smith and Frances J. Miller,
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. E-4056)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman,
Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree.

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said
Vanoy Johnson, Harold Johnson, Sadie J. Smith and Frances J. Miller, all the
right, title and interest of the minor Defendant, Lois Johnson, in and to the following
described real estate, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or tract situate, lying and being in Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, on the Laurens Road about 3 1/2 miles East of the City of
Greenville and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the Laurens Road at a point 105 feet
Northwest of the joint corner of the estate of J. A. Adams and property belonging to
Conyers & Gower and thence running along the Laurens Road N. 31-15 W. 100 feet to a
point in said road; thence S. 41-30 W. 216 feet to iron pin in the line of property
belonging to J. F. Adams; thence along the joint line S. 31-15 E. 12 feet to iron pin;
thence S. 39-15 W. 567.6 feet to iron pin; thence S. 50-15 E. 100 feet to an iron pin;
thence N. 38 E. 532.6 feet to the beginning corner and being a portion of the property
conveyed by E. Inman, Master to Vanoy Johnson, et al, on December 14, 1928, by deed
recorded in Vol. 159, at page 312, and being designated as Lots Nos. 4, 6, 7, 8, and 9,
on a plat of the property belonging to the estate of J. A. Adams as made by W. J. Riddle,
Surveyor, on October 18, 1933."
