HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

R. M. Hughes,

"All that certain tract of land in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville,
STATE OF South Carolina, known and designated as Tract No. 5, according to a sub-division
and plat of the property of Mrs. Nannie Smith, made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, in August,
1929, containing 31.64 acres, more or less, and having the following mates and bounds and
courses and distances as shown by said plat, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake in center of road, at the northeast corner of Tract No.
6 and in line of Tract No. 4 and running thence along the line of Tract No. 6 S. 37.00 W.
2698 feet to a stake; thence N. 36.45 W. 572.5 feet to a stake at corner of Tract No. 3;
thence along the line of Tract No. 3 N. 37.00 E. 2420 feet to stake in center of said road
and in line of Tract No. 4; thence S. 54.40 E. 374.6 feet to a point in center of said road
at bend; thence continuing along the center of said road and in line of Tract No. 4, S.
63.45 E. 182.7 feet to the beginning corner and being a part of the land owned by Mrs.
Nannie Smith at the time of her death."
