TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. Insman

Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

Whereas, B. S. Henson and Annie Mary Fisher

on or about the 31st day of January in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and thirty four exhibited their petition complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Lyla Pearl Henson (Towler), Nettie Bell Henson, W. J. Fisher and Helen J. Fisher

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 12th day of Feb 1934, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Insman Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Lyla Pearl Henson (Towler) for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. E-1503)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Insman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree.

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Lyla Pearl Henson (Towler)

the following described property:

(1) All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Block Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the Town of Greer, and on the North side of Hubert St., and having the following meter and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Hubert St. corner of W. L. James lot and running thence along said W. L. James line 181 ft. to an iron pin, corner of W. B. Hudson and J. P. Posters' lots; thence along W. B. Hudson's line 54 2/3 ft. to an iron pin on W. B. Hudson's line; thence in a southerly direction 181 ft. to an iron pin on Hubert St.; thence along Hubert St. in an easterly direction 54 2/3 ft. to the beginning corner. Being the same property conveyed to W. J. Henson by G. W. Beach by deed dated May 16, 1921 recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book 62 at page 121.

Also (2) All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Block Springs Township, near the town of Greer, bounded by colored cemetery, near Needmore, and a new street from Cemetery and Robinson, said lot containing 1/2 acres, more or less, and being the same lot of land conveyed to W. J. Henson by D. A. Lister by deed dated June 1, 1915 recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Book 23 at page 568, reference to which is hereby crossed for a more complete description.
