Lot No. 6A; Beginning at a point at the corner of Lot No. 7 and an alley; running
thence with said alley for a distance of approximately 30 feet to a point at the corner
of Lot No. 6 and the said alley; running thence N. 77½ W. along the line of Lot No. 6
for a distance of approximately 89 feet; thence S. 41½ E. for a distance of approximately
35 feet to the corner of Lot No. 7; thence S. 77½ E. for a distance of approximately
102 feet to the beginning point.
