all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Being lots Nos. 19, 21 and 24 of the Hoke subdivision, according to a plat recorded in Plat Book 6, Page 54, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, said lots being situate on Gentry and Grandavant Streets, and being the same lots conveyed to Jane Wright by deeds recorded in Deed Book 98, page 421 and Deed Book 1113 page 96.
