

TITLE TO REAL ESTATE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, R. R. Moon, Frank Moon, Maxwell Moon, Joe Brown Moon and Grace Pepper Rhodes,

in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) in the State aforesaid. DOLLARS.

to us paid by J. A. Moon, Inc.,

and quitclaimed and quitclaim in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, ~~and~~ released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell ~~and~~ release unto the said

J. A. Moon, Inc. all right, title and interest whatsoever in or to the following described property:-

All those two certain lots of land in said County and State, in Ward 6 of the City of Greenville, as follows:-

Lot No. 1: Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Grove Street, and thence along said Street 50 feet to stake; thence in a southerly direction 130 feet to an iron pin; thence in a westerly direction 50 feet; thence in a northerly direction 130 feet to the beginning corner.

Lot No. 2: On Spring Street at the rear of the above described lot, having a frontage of 50 feet and a depth of 70 feet, known as Lot No. 22, on survey of W. A. Hudson, on March 21, 1908.

Being the same lots of land conveyed to J. A. Moon by J. Walter Moon and Mary Moon Chiles, Trustees, by deed dated April 6, 1920, and by J. A. Moon to Peoples State Bank of South Carolina, as Trustee, and by the latter to J. A. Moon, Inc.
