All that certain tract of land, lying and being on the Neely
Farm Road, in Austin Township, in Greenville County, in the
State of South Carolina, adjoining lands now or formerly
belonging to Allen J. Sullivan, Ed. Griffin, William Baldwin
and others, being a part of the Bill Black lands, containing
thirty eight (38) acres, more or less,
Also, all that piece or parcel of land, lying and situate
on the Standing Springs Road in Austin Township, in Green-
ville County, in the State of South Carolina, containing sixty
(60) acres, more or less, and being the same lands conveyed
by A. White to J. A. Martin, and Allen J. Sullivan, by deed
recorded in Book 42, Page 58, and by J. A. Martin to Allen
J. Sullivan by deed recorded in Book 50, at Page 65, reference
being here made to said deeds for a more particular de-
scription.
