All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the East side of St. Clair Street, just outside the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as lots Nos. 6 and 7 in Block "A", of a subdivision known as Hill Crest, property of the Estate of T. Q. Donaldson and having according to a plat thereof prepared by F. G. Rogers, Engineer, which said plat is recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A", at page 217, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

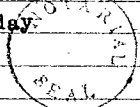
