All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and
being in the State of South Carolina, also City and County of Green-
ville in the First Ward of said City on Hampton Avenue, and hav-
ing the following metes and bounds, to wit:
Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Hampton Avenue and
running thence N. 40° E. 231 feet to an iron pin on a Sixteen Foot
Alley; thence N. 43° 44' 34" E. 66 feet to an iron pin on a Twenty Foot
Alley; thence S. 49° W. with said alley, 22 3/4 feet to Hampton
Avenue; thence S. 36° 13' E. with said Hampton Avenue, 60 feet to
the beginning corner, this being the same lot of land conveyed
to me by John T. Bramlett by deed dated 5th day of April 1919,
