1. All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township,
County and State aforesaid, about four miles Northwest of Greenville Court House
near the Paris Mountain Road, containing 1.3 acres, more or less, and described more
fully in deed from M. A. Bryant to T. F. Massey and Carrie P. Massey, dated November
19, 1925, and recorded in Vol. 106, page 248, R. M. C. office for Greenville County.

2. Also, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township,
County and State aforesaid, about four miles Northwest of Greenville Court House on
Paris Mountain Road, containing .49 acres, more or less, and described more fully in
deed from Henry P. McGee to Carrie P. Massey, dated January 27, 1925, and recorded
in Vol. 98, page 343, R. M. C. office for Greenville County.

3. Also, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township,
County and State aforesaid, about four miles Northwest of Greenville Court House near
the Paris Mountain Road and containing .18 acres, more or less, and being more fully
described in deed from M. A. Bryant to Carrie P. Massey, dated July 15, 1925, and
recorded in Vol. 103, page 182, R. M. C. office for Greenville County.

The above three lots are the same conveyed to me by Carrie P. Massey, deed
being recorded in Vol. 151, page 76, R. M. C. office for Greenville County. Also,
all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County
and State aforesaid, in Greenville Township, near the Buncombe Road and Verner Springs
and fronting Martin Street, having the following metes and bounds according to a plat
made by C. M. Furman, Engineer, 1928, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the South
side of Martin Street and running thence S. 13 W. 128.8 feet to an iron pin; thence
S. 77-30 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 13-50 E. 139 feet to an iron pin on
Martin Street; thence along Martin Street N. 88-15 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner,
and being known as the rear portion of Lots Nos. 228 and 229, as shown on plat re-
corded in Plat Book "A", page 279, being the same lot of land conveyed to me by P. B.
Bishop by deed dated December 22, 1928, and recorded in Vol. 133, page 134, R. M. C.
office for Greenville County. In this last mentioned deed my name was erroneously
spelled "Marry" instead of "Mary".
