Received to it in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the Mortgage Corporation of Virginia, the owner and Assuree of a judgment in the sum of Three Hundred Sixty Four & 1/2 Dollars (\$364.75) Decree against J. H. Berry, et al., said judgment being recorded in the office of the Clerk of Court of Common Pleas for Greenville County, S.C., as judgment roll No. 6-1875, does hereby release and forever discharge the following described property from the lien of said judgment:

One (1) certain lot or parcel of land situated, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, near the corporate limits of the city of Greenville and being known and designated as Lot No. 18, in Block "A", of the Mountain View Subdivision, and having, according to plat made by Dalton & Mace Engineers, May, 1926, the following width and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Gully Street, which new pin is 25 feet South of Brunswick Street, and running thence N. 13 E. 75 feet to an iron pin on a ten foot alley; thence with said alley S. 44 E. 55 feet to an iron pin, Corner of Lot No. 19; thence with the line of that lot S. 72 E. 30 ft. N. 3 E. 5 feet to an iron pin on Gully Street; thence with said Street N. 13 W. 21 feet to the point of beginning.
