Hartzog, bankrupt, owned only an undivided one-half interest in the premises herein above described, the price thereinafore set out is all that said property could reasonably be expected to bring.

It is Ordered and adjudged that the said sale be confirmed and that upon compliance by the said Mechanics Building and Loan Association with the terms of sale as provided in the Order of sale, that the said R. K. Stussell, as Trustee, do make and deliver to the said Mechanics Building and Loan Association, a title to the land herein above described, the same being an undivided one-half interest of O. B.
