 An Agreement having been reached between the
 City of Greenville, hereinafter called the city of the first part,
 and North State Water and Sewer Sub-District Committee,
 hereinafter called Committee, of the second part, which agreement
 permits the said City to empty certain sewage into the line
 owned by the Committee, and in turn give the Committee certain
 rights of way, all of which is hereinafter in full, more there-
 fore, this agreement entered into between the said parties
 witnesses:

That for and in consideration of the sum of one (1.00)
 dollar to it in hand paid and we further consideration of the
 Agreement by the Committee permitting the City when so de-
 sired and without payment thereon to pour into a sewer
 into the Committee sewer these additional lateral sewer
 lines as may be required to take care of the sewage which
 may originate in that section of the City lying north of the
 City's so called Wilson Street School sewer Main, which Main
 line runs and carries the sewage of the Whitehall Street sewer
 line and the Main constructed by the Committee, the City
 hereby grants to the Committee the right of way and privilege
 for the sewer main hereinafter mentioned through the lot
 fronting North Main Street and the right of way and
 privilege to the use of its Whitehall Street sewer Main and the
 consideration with the sewer Main of the Committee from the
 Ashley Avenue Section.

In testimony whereof the City of Greenville has duly
 authorized officers and the North State Water and Sewer Sub-
 District Committee do hereby in duplicate set their hands and
 seals, binding themselves, their successors and assigns forever,
 by this agreement, this 27 day of May, 1932.
