C., the Trustees of said Church were directed for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars to convey to Alice T. Bryant and Benj. F. Bryant all interest which said Church might be entitled to under the will of Ann White, deceased; and

Whereas, said Trustees did receive said sum and did execute a conveyance of all interest which this Church might have under the will of Ann White, deceased; and

Whereas, there does not appear a record of the approval of the sale by the Quarterly Conference as provided by the Discipline of this Church.

Now, Therefore, in order to supply said record showing the authorization of said sale by the Quarterly Conference of this Church;

Be it Resolved by the Quarterly Conference of Jno. Wesley Methodist Episcopal Church, Greenville, S. C., that the conveyance by T. J. Bryant, Albert Nesbitt, J. W. Smith, Jno. G. Moore, H. L. Parker, J. P. Chappell, Press Brown, Perry Nesbitt, and N. C. McDaniel, as Trustees of Jno. Wesley Methodist Episcopal Church, Greenville, S. C., to Alice T. Bryant and Benj. F. Bryant, in consideration of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, as therein recited, which conveyance was duly authorized at a meeting of the Official Board of said Jno. Wesley Methodist Episcopal Church, Greenville, S. C., and which is dated May _____, 1926, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deeds Volume 116, at page 118, be and the same is hereby fully confirmed, approved and ratified.

The property conveyed is described as follows:-

"All the land owned by the said Ann White at the time of her death, wheresoever the same may be situate, and especially that lot upon which the resided, situate in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the north side of West Washington Street, having a depth of 83 feet, more or less, and extending westward from the property of the Presbyterian Church to Academy Street."

Be it further resolved that in the event that should hereafter any owner of all, or any part of, said premises, at any time, request the execution and delivery of other or further papers confirming said deed, that the proper officers and/or trustees of this Church be and they are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute and deliver such other and further conveyance and/or instruments as may be necessary to vest in Alice T. Bryant and Benj. F. Bryant and/or their heirs and assigns such interest as this Church would take under the will of Ann White, deceased, in the event the said Benj. F. Bryant should predecease his mother, Alice T. Bryant.
