By authority vested by will of Mrs. E. A. Wood, deceased in the sale and transferring of Real Estate.

This Agreement is made and entered into this tenth day of August, 1928, by and between W. D. McCorkle, Executor and Della T. McRugh, Executrix, of the Estate of Mrs. E. A. Wood, deceased party of the first part and J. C. Cunningham, John A. Robinson, Sr., and R. Perry Turner, members of the board of the Water and Light Commission of the town of Greer, S. C. party of the second part, Witnesseth.

That the party of the first part hereby covenants and agrees to grant and convey unto the party of the second part a right of way through the lands of the Estate of the late Mrs. E. A. Wood, along the line as surveyed by the Engineer for the town of Greer, as outlined on the Blue Print made for the town of Greer for the purpose and use of laying and operating and maintaining a Sewer Line through the said premises. The same to be placed not less than three feet under ground, except where crossing the branch. This is for the consideration of a connecting Sewer Line to be laid, operated and maintained by the party of the second part. The said connecting Line beginning at a point in South Main St., opposite the front yard fence of the residence occupied by F. J. Henderson and extending down said street to the intersection of the Brushy Creek road, thence down the Brushy Creek road to a point about two hundred feet below an old cattle pit crossing, thence about a 45 degree right turn seroes the corn patch to the wain Sewer line connection.

Party of the second part covenants and agrees for the right of way herein designated to grant unto the party of the first part and their assigns the privilege of making Sewer connections on each side of the main and connecting lines herein designated as may be required for future development of the property of the aforesaid Estate.

Party of the first part hereby agrees to pay a maximum charge of fifty cents per month for all Sewer connections made outside of the City Limits. The city of Greer to furnish water for same.
