in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Miriam J. Browne and L. Halbert Browne, their heirs at law and  
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Cleveland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

about twenty-four miles north of Greenville Court House,  
near the Jones Gap Road, on the north side of Middle Saluda River containing 1.65 acres more or less, and having the following courses and distances according to survey made by W. A. Hester Surveyor May 20, 1927. Beginning at a stake on the north bank of Middle Saluda River corner of land now or formerly belonging to Peace, and running thence with Peace line N 28° 8' 812 feet to stake and above; thence S 15° 34' 24 343 feet to iron pin; thence S 9° 34' 24 497 feet to stone on bank of Middle Saluda River, thence with said river 44 feet to the beginning course.
