On the west side of the new Paris Mountain Road, adjoining  
 lands of C. O. Allen Estate, H. P. McAll and Harry Stephenson,  
 containing 4.18 acres, more or less, and having the following  
 metes and bounds and courses and distances according to  
 a survey and plat made by P. C. Dalton, Eng., August, 1920.

Beginning at an iron pin in the center of the new  
 Paris Mountain Road, at a point where said road is
