all that piece, parcel or lot of land... situate, lying and being on the Southeast corner of Houston St. and Pearl Avenue, being part of lot known and designated as lot Number One in Block "F", of the Chapin Springs Land Company, as shown on a Plat recorded in Plat Book "A", at page 41, and having the following metes and bound, to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of Houston St. and Pearl Ave. (Southeastern corner), and running thence with Pearl Avenue N. 89-44 E. 104.2 ft. to an iron pin; thence S. 2-0 E. 25 ft. to a point; thence S. 88 W. 105 feet to a point on Houston St.; thence with Houston St., N. 2-58 E. 26 feet to the beginning corner; this being part of the same lot of land conveyed to me, as Lyda P.
