all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

and being known and designated as Lots 1 and 2 of the property of the Grantor according to survey and Plat made by W. A. Bester, Surveyor, March, 1926, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of the Buncombe Road at a corner of land now or formerly belonging to Hawkins, running thence with said Buncombe Road, S. 14 N. 100 feet to an iron pin joint corner of Lots 1 and 2; thence, continuing with said Buncombe Road, S. 16 N. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 2 and 3; thence, with joint line of said Lots N. 73 W. 315 feet to an iron pin in Grassy Branch; thence, down the meanders of said Branch 109 feet to an iron pin at corner of Hawkins' Land; thence, with his Land S. 86 1/2 W. 319 feet to the beginning corner; and containing 1 1/10 acres more or less.
