do hereby give and convey unto D. S. Verdin, and his heirs and
successors, the writing of this instrument,

(We receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have Counted, Received, Sold and Relieved, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

D. S. Verdin, all of our right, title and interest in
and to the following described tract of land:
All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land
situate, lying and being in Petetown Township, County
and State aforesaid bounded by lands of C. S. Verdin,
P. O. Bennett and others, having the following metes and
bounds: Beginning at a stone to S. S. Verdin's corner and
extending thence S. 35° E. 21.92 to a iron pin in the road
near W. P. Brown's, thence along the "old" road (now in
procession) 4.00 rods to bridge, thence N. 16° W. 2.88 to a stone;
thence N. 30° E. 5.20 to a limestone, thence N. 30° E. 19.60 to a
stone, thence N. 30° E. 31.20.40 to a stone; thence S. 29° E. 58.
.12.00 to the beginning corner, and containing 38.34 acres,
more or less. And let us the same tract of land convey
to C. S. Verdin and Ida O. Verdin to him on January 26, 1929,
and recorded on Vol. 138 at page 247, R. M. C. Office for
Greenville County, S.C."
