All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in
O'Neal Township, Greenville County and State of South Carolina, and having the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stone on W. J. Stones corner on Mrs. Edwards line and running
with said line to Ambrose Williams corner 18 rods and 30 links; thence with Williams line
24 rods to a stone in a West course 24 rods and 13 links to a stone on Riley Neals line;
thence with said line in a South course 36 rods and 3 links to the beginning corner and
containing Three and half ($3\frac{1}{2}$) acres, to be the same more or less. Bounded by lands of
Riley Neal, Estate of R. W. Edwards, Ambrose Williams and W. J. Stone. I also agree to
bind myself my Administrators, Executors to grant a perpetual right to way to said tract
of land. This being the same tract of land conveyed to me by W. J. Stone under date of
April 16th, 1923, in R. M. C. book 88, at page 160.

Beaver dam creek N. $6\frac{1}{2}$ E. 2.25 to a stone; thence Croping creek S. $41\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3.42 to a
hickory, thence S. 73 E. 3.50 to a R. O. thence S. 77 E. 4.15 to a stone in fence, thence
N. $20\frac{1}{2}$ W. 8.30 to a poplar, thence N. 63 E. 12.40 to a stone, thence N. $25\frac{1}{2}$ W. 11.80 to a
R. O. thence S. 36 W. 19.00 to a poplar, thence S. $45\frac{1}{2}$ W. drop th^s creek 1.38 to the
