all that certain tract or parcel of land in said County
and State near the town of *Paik* and at or near the
site of the former "Camp Seiler" and being known and
described as tract No. 4 of the G. D. Allen estate, and
shown in a subdivision and plat of same made by
H. S. Steele, Surveyor, April 24, 1925, and having the
following metes and bounds and courses and distances,
as shown in said plat, to-wit: Beginning at an
iron pin, N. 71° E. at the southeast corner of said tract,
thence being the southwest corner of tract No. 2 and in
line of land of J. A. Cole and running thence along the
line of tract No. 2, N. 31° E. 8.70 to an iron pin at corner
of tract No. 2, thence along the line of tract No. 2, N. 11° E.
6.24 to an iron pin, N. 71° E. thence N. 77° 34' W. 4.70 to
an iron pin, thence N. 23° E. 6.00 to a stake by M. C.;

2.80 to a point in the Butterfield Road, thence along
said Road, S. 13° 34' W. 10.90 to an iron pin, thence S. 77° E.
6.22 to an iron pin at the beginning corner, and con-
