

General Permit

Received of the State of South Carolina through the South Carolina State Printing Commission, One and 10/100 (\$1.00) Dollars in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Commission, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of telephone, including the necessary poles, wires and fixtures upon, over and across the property which I own or in which I hold an interest, in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, and upon and along the roads or highways adjoining said property, said sum to be received in full payment for said right, and also for the right to permit the attachment of the wires of any other company, or person to said poles and fixtures, and the right to time and cut trees along said lines so far as these and other trees stand at least 20 feet, and the right to cut all dead or dying trees that in falling would reach the wires, and the further right to erect and set the necessary guy and brace poles and anchors, and to attach thereto and to erect the necessary guy wires; said sum being received in full payment therefor. Said right-of-way is divided as follows:

Beginning on East when I own Fort Hill Creek property line of J. H. Cleveland and M. C. Ferguson run through woods in rear of said house, thence across road and run this 1/4 mile to road, crossing property line between J. H. Cleveland and J. M. Cottrell a distance of approximately one-half mile.
