

Whereas on April 11, 1933, J. D. Burnett granted a right of way to the City of Greenville for the erection of a water line and electric pole line to South Tyger River, said right of way being recorded in R. M. Office for Greenville County, in Deed Book 147, page 41, and whereas the width of said right of way was not specified in said recorded instrument, and it has been agreed between J. D. Burnett and the City of Greenville that the said right of way across the lands of J. D. Burnett shall be fixed at a width of twenty-five (25) feet for its entire length.

It is resolved at a meeting of the Commissioners of Public Works held June 6, 1933, that the right of way across the lands of J. D. Burnett for the Water Line and Electric Pole Lines of the City of Greenville to South Tyger River be fixed at a width of 25 feet for its entire length.
