

Whereas on April 11, 1928, J. H. Burnett granted a right of way to the City of Greer for the erection of a water line and of electric pole line to South Tyger River, said right of way being recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 147, page 41, and whereas the width of said right of way was not specified in said recorded instrument, and it has been agreed between J. H. Burnett and the City of Greer that the said right of way across the lands of J. H. Burnett shall be fixed at a width of twenty five (25) feet for its entire length.

It is resolved at a meeting of the Commissioners of Public Works held June 6, 1933, that the right of way across the lands of J. H. Burnett for the Water Line and Electric Pole Line of the City of Greer to South Tyger River be fixed at a width of 25 feet for its entire length.
