

of such damages.

It is further provided that should any of the projects for the operation of a service station or craft premises be required at any time during the term of this lease, the lessor may, at its option, forthwith terminate the lease without incurring any further liability thereunder.

After the expiration of the term of this lease, the lease shall continue in full force and effect from year to year upon the same terms and conditions until terminated by either party giving to the other ninety days written notice of its intention to terminate said lease.

All promises, understandings, covenants and agreements made by the lessor and/or the lessee shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the lessor and the lessee and their respective heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns. In witness whereof, the lessor has hereunto set his hand and seal, and the said lessee has caused this instrument to be executed and its corporate seal to be affixed by its proper corporate officer thereunto duly authorized the day and year first above written.
