

"All that tract or parcel of land, situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the Town of Greenville, on the south side of Oak Street, having the following descriptions:

Beginning on Oak Street, like F. P. McBurnell lot as a corner, thence thence running Northwards 45 feet along Oak Street, thence along said street Southwest 15 feet, thence Southwards 45 feet to the McBurnell line, thence along the McBurnell line 45 feet to the beginning corner, and being the corner lot of land described in the said Deed of J. Griffis by G. E. Gill dated February 21, 1906, and recorded in the Deed Books Plat Register, Vol. 128, at the Office for Greenville County.

"All that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows: West boundary of said parcel, more or less, infinite, being said Greenville Boundary, in the County and State aforesaid, about one and one-half miles west of Greenville Court House, three and one-half miles from the northern slope of State Rte. 4, and corner by a point made by J. W. Donahue, of Greenville and Turner, said lot fronting north on a forty-foot street and running back eastwardly one hundred six feet to a stake in the depth of road lot nos. 48 to estate 24 more; thence a line parallel with said street and thence east to a stake 24 more on line of lot nos. 48 and thence with said lot 48 feet to a stake 38 on said 48-foot street, thence with said street eastwardly 50 feet to the beginning corner, etc.
