Lot No. 6--Beginning at the corner of Lot No. 5 and runs thence along the line of this lot N. 20-45 W. 205.3 feet to the line of Lot No. 3; thence N. 82-25 W. 55 feet to the corner of Lot No. 7; thence along the line of this lot N. 7-05 W. 183.4 feet to James Street; thence along James Street S. 70-00 E. 55 feet to the beginning corner.

Lot No. 7--Beginning at the corner of Lot No. 6 on James Street and runs thence N. 21-05 E. 183.4 feet to the line of Lot No. 2; thence N. 82-25 W. 88 feet to the corner of Lot No. 8; thence along the line of this lot S. 11-17 W. 180.1 feet to James Street; thence along this Street S. 73-21 E. 55 feet to the beginning corner.

Also: All that lot of land, in said County and State, in or near the City of Greer, on the South side of James Street. Beginning at a stake on James Street and runs thence S. 6-30 W. 225 feet to an alley; thence N. 76-30 W. 74.4 feet to a stake; thence N. 6-16 W. 221.5 feet to James Street; thence S. 78 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner and being known as Lot No. 8 of the J.
