Howard's corner and running thence N. 65-75 W. 15.00 to a stake on the branch, thence down the measurement of said branch 26.50 to the fork of the branch thence S. 36 E. 22.20 to a post, thence S 20- W. 91 links to a spring, thence S 76- 25 E. 1.16 to a stone, thence S 36 E. 5.90 to a stone, thence S 11 W. 19 45 to the beginning corner and containing 28.82 acres more or less, and being a part of the same tract of land conveyed to Augustus Howard that part thereof which Margaret J.
