legal rank and priorities, in so far as the funds in hand will permit, and to pay over any surplus, without interest, to me or my executors or administrators if demand be made therefor.

In the event of a vacancy in the trusteeship, and as often as the same may occur, Miss Amelia A. Metts and Saint Andrews Mission, or their executors, administrators, successors or assigns may appoint in writing a trustee in whom shall be vested the title to any property belonging to the said trust estate, together with all powers and discretion hereby entrusted to the original trustee.

And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said grantee and his successors and assigns, against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
