Wynn, the owner of lands on and near Ready River in the County and State aforesaid, do hereby release Brandon Corporation from any liability on account of or growing out of the construction, maintenance and operation by Brandon Corporation of a sewage and waste disposal system, including sewage disposal plant and filtering and dye waste holding and settling basins and pipe lines emptying into Ready River at or near its plant and property near Travelers Rest in the County and State aforesaid and above the lands owned by me, and do hereby grant unto Brandon Corporation, its successors and assigns the right and easement to maintain and operate a sewage and waste disposal system and to empty into Ready River the effluent therefrom.
