Township, Greenville County—State of South Carolina.

All that pieces, parcel or tract of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, S.C. containing 26.7 acres, more or less, and described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin 34 rods running thence S. 71° 31' 26" to stone on J. A. Henderson's line; thence S. 20° 38' E. 7-20 to post or Fork Shoals Road; thence S. 38 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3-74 to a stone; thence S. 73.25 E. 5-24 to an iron pin in road; thence N. 62 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 10.50 thence 1 pin in Concrete Road; thence N. 69 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 2-09 to a head in road; thence S. 80 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 1-58 to a Cat. thence N. 57 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 2-50 to a stake; thence N. 26 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 12-07 to the beginning corner.
