In the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said T. J. Fowler

all that piece, parcel or tract of land in

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land
 situated, lying and being in Austin Township, County
 and State aforesaid, located on the north side of the
 Scuffletown public roads, adjoining lands of W. H.
 Mahaffey & B. Gilbert, myself, T. A. Fowler a citizen, and
 having the following lines and bounds:—Beginning
 at an iron pin in the Scuffletown Road, on Mahaffey line
 and running thence N. 67 E. 446 ft. to a stake, thence
 N. 20 E. 13675 ft. to an iron pin, corner of Mrs.
 Lola Cox and Mrs. Lea Burdett, thence with Mrs. Burdett's
 line S. 86-30 E. 1360 ft. to an iron pin on Gilbert's line,
 thence with Gilbert's line S. 19 E. 687.5 ft. to an iron
 pin, T. A. Fowler's corner, thence with Fowler's line N.
 16-30 W. 822 ft. to a stake, thence S. 32 W. 1350 ft. to
 an iron pin, in the road, thence along said road
 N. 52 W. 352 ft. to bend, thence further along road N.
 52 W. 500 ft. to the beginning corner, containing
 27.59 acres, more or less according to field notes of
 H. J. Reddick Surveyor, June 1st, 1924.

A part of the consideration of this conveyance is
 that said T. J. Fowler shall pay to maker, L. A. Fowler
 \$60.00 per year as interest, on value set upon the land
 herein conveyed, during life of the maker; and if
 said amount shall not be paid as above stipulated
 this conveyance shall become null and void, and
 the tract of land herein conveyed shall revert back
 to my estate.
