In the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Millie Lee Cobb, her heirs and assigns, all  
the right, title and interest, in and to  
all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

in the City of Greenville, containing one-fifth of an acre  
more or less, having the following lines and bounds,  
to wit:

Beginning on Anderson Street, corner of Brissey lot,  
and thence running northerly with Anderson Street  
43 feet to Dunbar Street, thence with Dunbar Street  
easterly with Dunbar Street 165 feet; thence parallel  
with Anderson Street southerly 43 feet to the Brissey  
lot; thence parallel with Dunbar Street easterly 165  
feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same lot conveyed to Manning  
Atkinson by W. J. Saxon and Mary C. Saxon, July 7,  
1921, by deed recorded in Deed Book 44, page 744,  
C. M. C. Office for Greenville County; the grantor  
and grantees herein are the sole heirs at law and  
distributives of the said Manning Atkinson, now deceas-  
ed, who died seized and possessed of said land.

As a part of the consideration for said deed,  
the said grantee does and agrees to pay a certain
