release unto the said Harristett L. Donaldson:

THESE ARE THE NAMES OF THE SONS OF JACOB WHICH CAME OUT OF EGYPT WITH HIM.

All that certain place, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 14 on plat of property of the Estate of S. Q. Donaldson made by C. M. Furman, Engineer, May, 1930, which plat is recorded in the R. L. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "I" at page 28, and having, according to said plat, the following mates and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the south side of Crescent Court, which point is 180 feet west of the southwest intersection of McDaniel Avenue and Crescent Court, and running thence along the rear line of Lots Nos. 7 and 8, S. 9-0 W. 149 feet to a point in line of Lot No. 16; thence along line of Lot No. 16, N. 81-0 W. 20 feet to an iron pin; thence still along line of Lot No. 16, N. 77-13 W. 45 feet to a point, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 13 and 14; thence along joint line of Lots Nos. 13 and 14, N. 9-6 S. 146.5 feet to a point in the south side of Crescent Court; thence along the south side of Crescent Court, S. 81-0 E. 95 feet to the point of beginning.

Whereas, a plat of the property of the Estate of T. G. McElroy was made by C. M. Furman, Engineer, June, 1827, which plat is recorded in the R. L. O. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "G", at page 157, and

Whereas, said plat shows a 40-foot street running parallel with McDaniel Avenue, the eastern side of said street being 150 feet west of the west side of McDaniel Avenue,

and Whereas, said 40-foot street has been closed by agreement entered into between all owners of property abutting on said street, which agreement is dated December 7th, 1936, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deeds Volume       , at page        and a revised plat has been made of said property by C. M.
