Rental Contract and Lease.

This agreement entered into this day by and between D. I. Lynn, Lessor, and

J. H. Mills & Son , Lasses, witnesseth: The Lessor above named agrees to and does hereby lease unto J. H. Mills  $^{\alpha}$ Son, the Lessess herein a certain lot of land situate in Oneal Township, County and State aforesaid, the same being a part of the D. I. Lynn home tract and located at the intersection of Buncome road and an unnamed road leading from said Buncombe read to the Milford Baptist Church, said let of land having been marked off by the parties hereto by stakes and containing One acre, more or less, bounded by lands of the lesser, Lee Ross and the above described highways.

The terms of this lease are that the Lessee is to have and to hold the propert for the surpose of operating a ginnery on same, and shall continue so long as said property is used for such purpose, the Lesses to have the privilege to terminate this lease without notice to the lessor.

For and consideration of the rights to the use of the premises above described the Lesses egrees to Pay an annual rental to the Lessor of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars per annum, to become due and payable on the first day of January, 1934, and on the first day of each year thereafter or so long as this loase is enfective and so long as the property is used for the purpose specified herein.

It is understood and agreed by the parties hereto that the Lessee, J. H. Mills \$ Som, are granted the privilege of erecting buildings on the said property for the purpose of ginning cotton, storing cotton and cotton seed, and that upon the termination of this lease they may have the right to remove from the premises all the buildings constructed by them as well as macuiner; placed there on, unless some other agreement is entered by the parties in writing with reference thereto.

It is further stipulated by the parties herein that this lease shall begin to run as of January 1st, 1933, and shall become operative on that date, that it shall be operative and effective so long as the said J. H. Mills or his son, Boyd Mills, shall desire to use the property for the purpose of ginning cotton. The Lesses agrees to give all waiste from ginnery, including motes, to the lesser, without cost.

To the foregoing terms and conditions of this instrument, we, the undersigned, hereby bind curselves, our heirs and assigns, this the lith day of October, 1932.
