Most, Therefore, Know all wen by these presents, That we, the undersigned Renald Williams Middleton, Basil Horman Middleton and Guaranty Executor & Trustee Company, Limited, each acting for and Dinding himself (itself), do hereby name, constitute and appoint Staphen Nettles, of Greenfillo, South Carolina, United States of America, our true and lawful agent and attorney-in-fact, and do authorise and empower him to accept service of process for each of us in any action or other legal proceeding brought or to be brought in any Court in Greenville County, South Carolina, in connection with or concerning the winding up and final settlement of the Estate of Elizabeth Middleton Herrard, deceased; to file such answers and other pleadings in our behalf in such actions or proceedings as he may deem proper; to appear for and represent us in said actions and proceedings; to do all such things as he may does proper and for our respective best interests in connection with the said Estate and any actions or other legal preceedings concerning the same; and to collect and in our respective names raceipt for all sums or money and scourities which we maybe entitled to receive for the Administrator of the Estate of Elizabeth Middleton Heyward, deceased, or from the Master in Equity, or other officer or person appeinted by order of court to sell the roal estate of said Estate and distribute the proceeds of sale,

The object of this power of attorney is to confer upon our attorney, above named, full power and authority, in his discretion, to do what he deems necessary and proper, in court and out of court, to protect our respective interests in the Estate of Elizabeth Middleton Heyward, deceased, and to turn same into cash, and we do hereby, each for himself (itself) ratiry and confirm all that our said attorney may do in the premises, including his execution of receipts, releases or other forms of acquittance for money paid to him for our account in connection with the closing of said Estate; the said asts of our said attorney to bind each of us as fully as if performed by us.
