In the proportion of an undivided one half interest in that certain lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville; Beginning at an iron pin on the right of way of the Columbia and Greenville Railroad (branch of Southern railway) at the corner of lot of Parrish & Gower and running thence with the said right of way in a North westernly direction 100 feet to an iron pin; thence in a North easternly direction 200.1 feet to an iron pin on Mayberry Street; thence North Mayberry street S. 59-10 E. 100 feet along Mayberry street to an iron pin corner Parrish and Gower; thence with their line S. 32-10 W. 200.1 feet to the beginning corner.
